My name is Dr. Jackie Meyer and I am asking that you consider me for a position on the MNRS Nominating Committee. I have over 30 years of clinical nursing experience, and I am currently a Professor in the Nursing Program at Allen College in Waterloo, Iowa where I have served as the Assistant Dean in the Graduate Nursing program since 2009. My primary teaching responsibilities are in the areas of health care policy, economics, and financing; evidence-based practice and clinical scholarship; and nursing and health professions education, including courses in the Allen College EdD program. I also work with numerous MSN and DNP students to develop and implement evidence based practice projects, and with EdD students in support of their dissertation work. My areas of research interest are social determinants of health in primary care settings, and support for clinical adjunct nursing faculty. I didn't earn my PhD until 2014, however, so I am a relative novice in the area of nursing research. As such, MNRS has been one of my greatest sources of support in terms of my nursing scholarship. I have been a member of MNRS since 2012, served on the Nursing Education Research Interest Group (RIG) Awards Committee from 2014-2015, and have served as chair of that committee from 2015 to the present time. I am also an active member of the following organizations: Pi Kappa and Alpha Nu chapters of Sigma Theta Tau International (Counselor, Pi Kappa Chapter), the American Nurses Association, Iowa Nurses Association (Northeast Iowa Council member), the Midwest Nurses Research Society, and the Council for the Advancement of Nursing Science.
