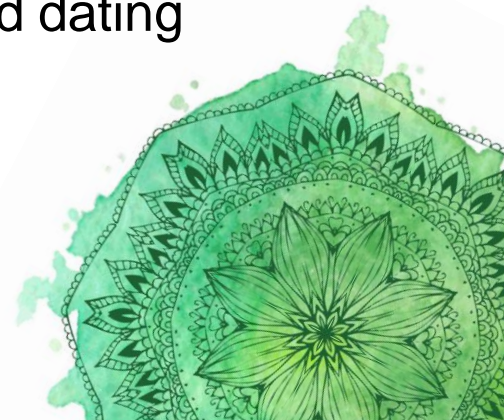
Participants
