

Palliative & End of Life Care RIG DISTINGUISHED RESEARCHER AWARD

DUE: December 3, 2019, 5:00 PM Eastern

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD: The purpose of this award is to recognize a researcher who has made a substantial contribution to palliative and end of life care science and/or practice over time.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- The nominee must hold a doctoral degree.
- The nominee's research has significantly advanced the science and/or practice of palliative and end
 of life care.
- The nominee's publication record reflects a continuous contribution to science and/or practice of palliative and end of life care throughout her/his career.
- The nominee has disseminated findings at local, regional, and national levels.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The nominee must be a member of MNRS in good standing.
- The nominee must be a current member of the MNRS Palliative & End of Life Care Research Interest Group.
- The nominee should be considered to be a senior researcher in the field, as demonstrated by distinguished and continuous contribution to the advancement of palliative and end of life care science throughout her/his career.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Each nomination packet should include:

- A statement (1-2 pages) that addresses how the nominee's work has made a distinguished and consistent contribution to the science and/or practice of palliative and end of life care
- Two publications (if "in press", include letter of acceptance) that represent the nominee's program of research
- Current curriculum vitae
- The nominee must acknowledge her/his willingness to be considered for the award on the nomination form
- Individuals may self-nominate. Self-nominations should also include one letter of support from a colleague that speaks to the qualifications of the nominee.

NOTIFICATION

The award recipient will be notified January 2020. The award will be presented at the Research Interest Group Meeting during the Annual Research Conference. The awardee is encouraged to be present to receive the award and will be invited to provide a brief presentation (up to 10 minutes) of her/his research during the RIG meeting.
