

Palliative & End of Life Care RIG OUTSTANDING PUBLICATION AWARD

DUE: December 3, 2019, 5:00 PM Eastern

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD: The purpose of the Outstanding Publication Award is to bestow recognition on a Palliative and End-of-Life Care Researcher for an outstanding published manuscript.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- Publication significantly advances the science and/or practice of palliative and end-of-life care.
- Publication is current (published within the past 1-2 years).
- Publication is in a peer-reviewed respected research journal.
- The applicant must be the 'first author' on the publication.
- A research publication may be submitted only once in a two year cycle.
- The manuscript must have been accepted for publication at the time of submission for the section award.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

• The applicant/nominee is a member of MNRS and member of the Palliative and End-of-Life care Research Interest Group.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS: To submit for this award, you must include the following two items:

- 1. A letter submitted by the author or a research colleague who is familiar with the research that briefly outlines the significance, innovation, scientific rigor, and impact of the research to palliative and end-of-life care. Please include the following information in the letter:
 - ✓ Nominee name, credentials and contact information (self-nominations are welcome).
 - \checkmark Reference for the publication.
 - ✓ Nominator's name, signature, and contact information (if applicable).
- 2. PDF of the nominated manuscript

NOTIFICATION: Applicants will be notified of the RIG Awards Committee decisions in January of 2020. RIG awards will be presented at the RIG meeting during the Annual Research Conference. Each awardee is strongly encouraged to be present to receive the award.
