

# Health Promoting Behaviors Across the Lifespan RIG SENIOR INVESTIGATOR AWARD

Nomination Deadline: December 3, 2019 (5:00 pm EST)

#### **PURPOSE OF THE AWARD**

To recognize a senior nurse researcher who has sustained an outstanding record of research and health promoting behavior issues in nursing.

## **CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD**

- The applicant's research has enhanced the science and/or practice related to health promoting behavior issues in nursing.
- The applicant's publication record reflects a contribution to the science and/or practice related to health promoting behavior issues in nursing.
- The impact of the applicant's research in health promoting behavior issues and related presentations are at a regional and national level.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- The applicant must hold a doctorate degree.
- The applicant should have a record of research focusing on issues related to health promoting behavior issues in nursing.
- The applicant is a member of MNRS and of the Health Promoting Behaviors Across the Lifespan Research Interest Group.
- Individuals can be either self-nominated or nominated by a current member of the Health Promoting Behaviors Across the Lifespan Research Interest Group.

#### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Nomination should include a brief statement (1-2 pages) of how the applicant's work has made a
  distinguished contribution to the science and/or practice related to health promoting behavior issues in
  nursing.
- Include a current copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae.
- Submit two of the applicant's most recent publications (if "in press", include letter of acceptance) or two publications that represent the applicant's research agenda.
- Two letters of support speaking to the applicant's research related to the award criteria, with at least one letter of support from an active MNRS member.
- An applicant may initiate the nomination, in which case the applicant is to acknowledge the nomination.
- The awardee must be willing to present her/his research at the Health Promoting Behaviors Across the Lifespan Research Interest Group meeting during the next annual conference.

# **NOTIFICATION**

The award recipient will be notified in January. The award will be presented at the RIG Meeting during the Annual Research Conference. The awardee is encouraged to be present to receive the award and will be invited to provide a brief presentation (up to 10 minutes) of their research at the RIG meeting.
