### CALL FOR COMPETITIVE SYMPOSIUM ABSTRACTS

**SYMPOSIUM TITLE:** *Breaking down Silos: Moving Innovation from the Bench to the Bedside*

**DEADLINE TO SUBMIT ABSTRACTS:** **JULY 20, 2020 by 11:59pm EDT**

**THEME:** This symposium will focus on empowering nurse researchers to transform their ideas from evidence-based innovations into practice. By including topics that appeal to a variety of stakeholders, the goal of this symposium is to bring together policy enthusiasts, data scientists, and digital health innovators for invigorating dialogue and discourse. Submissions that showcase collaborations and partnerships are encouraged. Potential topics may include but are not limited to the following:

- Research policy issues
- Challenges confronting health systems
- Accelerating findings into policy, health systems, and technology development
- The Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology Strategic Plan
- Guidance for Regulation on Data Science and Artificial Intelligence
- Information blocking and interoperability
- Implementation science
- PhD/DNP collaborations moving evidence into practice

From June 26, 2020 – July 20, 2020, abstracts can be emailed to Dr. Kim Powell ([powellk@missouri.edu](mailto:powellk@missouri.edu)) by the primary author. Abstracts are to be limited to 350 words and include the following: Purpose/Background, Framework, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.

Abstracts will be scored by each RIG's Symposium Committee according to significance, innovation, and fit with the proposed theme. One (1) Competitive Symposium of the top 3-5 abstracts will be submitted to the Program Planning Committee for a blind peer review. The primary author will be notified of their inclusion status for the submitted symposium by July 30, 2020 and, if included in the submitted symposium, of the final approval/acceptance status of the symposium by September 8, 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: Authors of abstracts which are not selected may submit to the General Call for Competitive Abstracts, which is open August 4, 2020 through October 22, 2020.
