The Adolescent Health RIIG is pleased to offer a call for abstracts for a proposed Guaranteed Symposium titled: ***Mental Health Issues in Adolescence and Young Adulthood***. Appropriate topics for this symposium **include but are not limited to** research related to:

- Lessons learned from working with mental health issues and adolescents/young adults during the pandemic
- Factors affecting mental health of adolescents/young adults (ie. technology use, pandemic, etc.)
- Strategies to improve the mental health of adolescents/young adults
- Use of innovative research methodologies and technology for studying mental health issues among adolescent/young adult populations

From June 5, 2021 – July 23, 2021, abstracts can be emailed to RIIG Past-Chair Kimberly Hartson (Kimberly.Rapp@Louisville.edu) by the primary author. Abstracts are to be limited to 350 words and include the following: Purpose/Background, Framework, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

Abstracts will be scored by the RIIG's Symposium Committee according to significance, innovation, and fit with our proposed theme. The primary author will be notified of their inclusion status for the submitted symposium by August 6, 2021 and, if included in the submitted symposium, of the final acceptance status of the symposium by September 3, 2021.

PLEASE NOTE: Authors of abstracts which are not selected may submit to the General Call for Competitive Abstracts, which is open August 9 through October 22, 2021.
