The Health Systems, Policy, & Informatics RIIG is pleased to sponsor a call for panelists for a proposed Guaranteed Symposium titled, “*Generating New Knowledge and Advancing Innovative Solutions through Nursing Research.*” In the era of big data and digital health, new knowledge is being generated to address the extensive unmet information needs of patients, clinicians, administrators, researchers, and health policy makers. The integration of novel approaches into clinical and population research and practice requires tremendous efforts from multiple disciplines, including nursing. A panel of experts will provide insights into recent advances in data science and informatics that are important to nurses and researchers from novice to expert in all areas of nursing. **Appropriate topics for this symposium include, but are not limited to the following:**

- Secondary research use of clinical data (i.e., EHR data)
- Machine learning and artificial intelligence
- eHealth/mHealth and telehealth applications
- Technology acceptance and use
- Informatics implementation
- Health Information exchange and interoperability
- Accelerating findings into policy, health systems, and technology development
- Informatics challenges and lessons learned during the pandemic
- Workflow adjustments implemented in response to the pandemic
- Patient engagement and empowerment
- Clinical decision support

From **June 28, 2021 – July 23, 2021**, abstracts can be emailed to Dr. Yun Jiang (jiangyu@umich.edu) by the primary author. Presentation proposals are to be limited to 350 words and include the following: Purpose/Background, Framework, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.

Proposals will be reviewed by members of the HSPI RIIG Symposium Committees according to significance, innovation, and fit with the proposed theme. One (1) Competitive Symposium of the top 3-5 proposals will be submitted to the Program Planning Committee for a blind peer review. The primary author will be notified of preliminary selection for the submitted symposium by **August 6, 2021**. Final confirmation of acceptance will be communicated by **September 8, 2021**.

PLEASE NOTE: Authors of abstracts which are not selected may submit to the General Call for Competitive Abstracts, which is open **August 9, 2021** through **October 22, 2021**.
