

Symptom Science RIIG MID-CAREER INVESTIGATOR AWARD

Deadline: December 3, 2021, 5:00 PM Eastern

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The purpose of this award is to recognize the contribution of a mid-career investigator who has made outstanding contributions to symptom science.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- The applicant must hold a PhD in nursing or a related field and have held an academic faculty position for ≥ 5 years. If the applicant has held an academic faculty position <5 years, please consider applying for the New Investigator Award.
- Has a publication record that reflects an ongoing contribution to symptom science and/or practice of symptom management.
- The applicant has disseminated findings at regional and national professional conferences.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must be a member of MNRS and the Symptom Science RIIG

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Nominations must be made by an active MNRS member (regular, student, or retired member); self-nominations will be accepted.

Each nomination packet should include:

- A two-page statement from the nominee describing their contributions to the continuous advancement of symptom science
- A current copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae
- One letter of support that addresses the significance of the nominee's research and contributions to symptom science
- Two publications from the nominee that highlight the contribution to symptom science and demonstrating the quality and rigor of the nominee's research

NOTIFICATION: The award recipients will be notified by early-January. The award will be presented at the Symptom Science RIIG Meeting and acknowledged during the Annual Research Conference. The awardee is encouraged to be present to receive the award and will be invited to provide a brief presentation (up to 5 minutes) of their research at the section meeting.
