PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The purpose of this award is to recognize the contribution of a new investigator who has conducted nursing research that has the potential to enhance the science and practice of Gerontological Nursing.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- Earned a doctoral degree within the past 7 years
- Has a publication record that reflects an ongoing contribution to the science and/or practice of Gerontological Nursing
- Has presented at local, regional, and national level
- Demonstrates evidence of funding to support research that will advance the science and practice of Gerontological Nursing

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must be a member of MNRS and the Gerontological Nursing Science RIIG
- The applicant must adhere to the nomination process as outlined below.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Nominations must be made by an active MNRS member (regular, student, or retired member); self-nominations will be accepted.

Each nomination packet should include:

- Current curriculum vitae of the nominee.
- One letter of support that addresses the significance of the nominee's research contributions to Gerontological Nursing science and/or practice.
- Copy of one publication that demonstrates the quality and rigor of the applicant's research.

NOTIFICATION: The award recipient will be notified in late January 2022. The award will be presented at the Gerontological Nursing Science Research and Implementation Interest Group meeting held during the Annual Conference. The recipient is encouraged to be present to receive the award and will be invited to make a brief oral presentation (up to 5 minutes) about their research.
