



Family Health Research & Implementation Interest Group **DISSERTATION AWARD** **2022**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The nominee is a member of the Family Health RIIG of MNRS.
- The dissertation must have been completed between **December 2019 and December 2021**.
- The dissertation contributes *specifically* to advancing the science of family health.
- The findings have been publicly disseminated beyond defense or accepted for presentation.
- The letter of support clearly delineates the quality of the dissertation.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Nominations must be made by an active MNRS member (regular, student, or retired member). Self nominations for the award will be accepted.
- The nomination packet should include the following:
 - a. A summary of the dissertation, double-spaced, maximum 1250 words in length. Include the title, problem, purpose, hypotheses/questions, framework, methods, findings, and significance to family health nursing.
 - b. The curriculum vitae of the nominee.
 - c. A letter of support from a dissertation committee member that addresses both the quality of the nominee's dissertation and its significance to family health nursing knowledge and/or practice.
 - d. Indication of agreement that the nominee, if selected as the awardee, will attend and briefly disseminate his/her dissertation findings at the annual business meeting and other assigned venue (e.g., posting abstract to the Family Health RIIG Section website and/or MNRS sites).

NOTIFICATION

The award recipient will be notified mid-January. The award will be presented at the Family Health RIIG Annual Meeting and acknowledged during the Annual Research Conference. The awardee must be present to receive the award and will be invited to provide a brief presentation (up to 10 minutes) of her/his research at the annual meeting and electronically share the nomination summary with section members.
