PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The purpose of this award is to recognize the contribution of an outstanding undergraduate student who has shown potential and participated in nursing research to advance the science and/or practice of palliative and end-of-life care in their future career.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- The nominee has evidence of scholarly activity or research participation in projects that will advance the science and/or practice of palliative and end-of-life care

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The nominee is an undergraduate student currently enrolled in an accredited BSN program in good standing
- The nominee must be a student member of MNRS and a member of the Palliative and End-of-Life Care Research Interest and Implementation Group

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS *Each nomination packet should include:*

1. A faculty letter of support or a nomination letter (1 page, single spaced) that addresses the significance of the student nominee's potential to advance palliative and end-of-life science and/or practice
2. Nominee's current resume
3. Please be sure that all submitted materials are clearly identified with the nominee's name in the file name.
4. Individuals may self-nominate. Self-nominations should include item #1 above, the statement from a peer colleague that addresses their work.

NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified of the RIIG Awards Committee decisions in January of 2022. RIIG awards will be presented at the RIIG meeting and acknowledged during the Annual Research Conference. Each awardee is strongly encouraged to be present to receive the award.
