PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The purpose of the Outstanding Publication Award is to bestow recognition on a Palliative and End-of-Life Care author for an outstanding published manuscript.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- Publication significantly advances the science and/or practice of palliative and end-of-life care.
- Publication is current (published within the past 1-2 years).
- Publication is in a peer-reviewed respected research journal.
- The applicant must be the 'first author' / or mentor on the publication.
- A publication may be submitted only once in a two-year cycle.
- The manuscript must have been accepted for publication at the time of submission for this award.
- Only one manuscript may be submitted per applicant.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant/nominee is a member of MNRS and member of the Palliative and End-of-Life care Research Interest and Implementation Group.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To submit for this award, you must include the following two items:

- A letter submitted by the author or a peer colleague who is familiar with the work that briefly outlines the significance, innovation, scientific rigor, and impact of the work to palliative and end-of-life care. Please include the following information in the letter:
 - ✓ Nominee name, credentials and contact information (self-nominations are welcome).
 - ✓ Reference for the publication.
 - ✓ Nominator's name, signature, and contact information (if applicable).
- PDF of the nominated manuscript

NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified of the RIIG Awards Committee decisions in January of 2022. RIIG awards will be presented at the RIIG meeting and acknowledged during the Annual Research Conference. Each awardee is strongly encouraged to be present to receive the award.
