GRADUATE STUDENT AWARD

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD: The purpose of this award is to recognize the accomplishment of a graduate student who demonstrates the potential to contribute significantly to adolescent/emerging adult health research.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

- The student has taken an active role in the participation of adolescent/emerging adult health research.
- The student demonstrates progress toward the production of scholarly work in regards to adolescent/emerging adult health research, including but not limited to PhD dissertation, DNP project, evidence-based practice project, and master's thesis.
- The student demonstrates significant potential for leadership.
- The student demonstrates significant academic potential as evidenced by participation in scholarly activities related to adolescent/emerging adults research while a graduate nursing student.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- The applicant is a member of MNRS or must join MNRS as a student member.
- The applicant is in a graduate nursing program, including masters, doctor of nursing practice, or doctor of philosophy.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

To submit for this award, you must provide the following items:

- A nomination letter (maximum of 2 pages on letterhead) submitted by an MNRS faculty member who is familiar with the nominee's scholarly work in adolescent/emerging adult health research. The letter should include:
 - ✓ Nominee's name, credentials, and contact information.
 - ✓ Description of meritorious achievement in relation to the above award criteria.
 - ✓ Nominator's name, credentials, signature, and contact information.
- A current copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae.
- The awardee must be willing to present their research at the Adolescent Research & Implementation Interest Group meeting during the next annual conference.

NOTIFICATION: Award recipients will be notified January of 2022. The awards will be presented at the Research & Implementation Interest Group Meeting during the Annual Research Conference. Awardees are encouraged to be present to receive the award and will be invited to provide a brief presentation (up to 10 minutes) of their research at the meeting.
