The purpose of this symposium is to highlight programs of research or evidence-based practice that focus on the following topics, but are not limited to these, as far as they meet the symposium and RIIG-related themes:

- Innovative approaches to developing and implementing nursing science to promote the health of diverse populations
- Use of technology and/or social media in developing and implementing nursing science to promote the health of a diverse population
- Addressing emerging factors affecting the implementation of nursing science
- Strategies to promote health equity through the implementation of nursing science of caring, compassion, healing, empowerment, and client-provider partnership

Abstracts: Abstracts are to be limited to 350 words and include the following: Purpose/Background, Framework, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.

Abstracts will be scored by the RIIG's Symposium Committee according to significance, innovation, and a good fit with the proposed theme of the Competitive Symposium. The top three to five abstracts will be submitted to the Program Planning Committee for a blind peer review. The primary author will be notified of their inclusion status for the submitted symposium by August 21, 2022, and of the final acceptance status by September 9, 2022.
