**SYMPOSIUM TITLE:** Enhancing access to Palliative/End of life Care: Innovations, Identifying Challenges, Overcoming Barriers

The Palliative and End-of-Life Care RIIG is pleased to offer a call for abstracts for our proposed Competitive Symposium titled, "Enhancing access to Palliative and End of Life Care: Innovations, Identifying Challenges, Overcoming Barriers."

Appropriate topics for this symposium include but are not limited to research related to:

- Strategies for overcoming barriers to access palliative and end of life
- Innovations/innovative models of care delivery for enhancing access to palliative and end of life care (For example using telehealth, social media, or other strategies etc.).
- Novel modalities and strategies for addressing palliative care domains including pain and symptom management, spiritual/psychosocial aspects, ethical and cultural aspects, caregivers and adaptations.
- Innovative approaches to recruitment and retention, data collection strategies, and other
  adaptive strategies for conducting high-quality palliative and EOL studies within the context of
  the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Innovations using patient/family centered palliative care research approaches

Abstracts should be submitted by the primary author via email to the RIIG Co-Chairs, Nasreen Lalani (lalanin@purdue.edu) and Justina Yevu Johnson (jynf7@mail.missouri.edu). Abstracts are limited to 350 words and must include the following: Purpose/Background, Framework, Methods, Results, and Conclusions. Submissions will be accepted through July 22, 2022, 11:59 pm EDT.

Abstracts will be scored by the RIIG's Review Committee according to relevance, significance, innovation, and fit with the proposed theme. For Competitive Symposium, 3-5 abstracts will be submitted to the Program Planning Committee for a blind peer review. The primary author will be notified of their inclusion status for the submitted symposium around <u>August 9, 2022</u>. If included in the submitted symposium, notification of the final acceptance will be sent by September 1, 2022.

PLEASE NOTE: Authors of the abstracts that are not selected may submit to the General Call for Abstracts, which is open through October 21, 2022.
