This symposium will include 3-6 oral presentations from RIIG members of the selected abstracts, as well as the potential for presentations by invited panelists.

Appropriate topics for this symposium include, but are not limited to:

- Innovative conceptual/theoretical approaches
- Reviews of literature that contribute to the advancement of the science
- Evidence based clinical applications for care of acutely and critically-ill patients and their families across the life span and health-care settings
- Empirical studies, particularly those that highlight innovative recruitment, data collection, or data analysis strategies
- Unique challenges and solutions in acute and critical care research and implementation
- New models and approaches to fostering collaboration among nurse-scientists and clinical scholars

Abstracts are to be limited to 350 words for any of the three types of submissions: research, evidencebased project, or literature review. Please include the following headings and information that correspond with your abstract type:

Research: Purpose/Background, Theoretical/conceptual framework, Method, Results, Conclusions

Evidence based project: Nature/scope of the project, Synthesis and analysis of supporting literature, Project implementation, Evaluation criteria, Outcomes, Recommendations

Literature review: Problem, Purpose, Search Strategy, Results of literature search, Synthesis of evidence, Implications for practice

Abstracts will be scored by the RIIG's abstract review committee according to significance, innovation, and fit with the proposed theme. The primary author will be notified of their inclusion status for the submitted symposium by August 9, 2022.

PLEASE NOTE: Authors of abstracts who are not selected to present at the RIIG symposium may submit to the MNRS General Call for Competitive Abstracts, which will be open on August 11, 2022.
